(Cattle should arrive by 4 p.m.)

The Youth Showmanship class and Commercial Heifer class will be open only to youth exhibitors (18 years of age and younger).

All animals (except Commercial Heifers) must be registered in their respective breed association. Original registration certificates for each animal will be required and tattoos may be checked by the show committee.

All exhibitors will adhere to the Tennessee Department of Agriculture Division of Animals Industries Fair Regulations in effect at the time of show. Each animal must have a health certificate.

All animals must remain until completion of the show.

Judges have been carefully selected. All persons making entries accept these judges and agree to abide by their decision. Protests upon any other grounds or against any other than judges must be made in writing to the chairman of the committee and must state fully and specifically upon what grounds the protest is being made.

A lot will be open for any breed with eight (8) animals showing with a minimum of two (2) exhibitors represented.

Advanced registration is required by Monday, Aug. 26, 2019 for entry in the Beef Cattle Show. On a piece of paper the following information should be listed: breed, sex, age, name of animal and registration number. The information may be mailed to Ronnie Barron, Extension Director, c/o U.T.
